RISE Learning Zone is committed to:-

- establishing and maintaining a culture of implementing equal opportunities in all that it does
- taking positive action in seeking to promote access for all.

Access To The Curriculum

RISE will:

- Provide an appropriate level of support to learners with disabilities tailored to their personal needs and circumstances, including 1:1 tuition, large print, colour overlays and other equipment as required.
- Embed a system of wrap around pastoral support, with parental and inter-agency working that puts the learner and their education at the centre, to find practical solutions to obstacles of learning.

Access to the site

Balloon Woods site:

- Wheelchair access to all rooms
- Wheelchair-friendly paths to main outdoor activity areas
- Disabled toilets with an emergency call system

Access to information

RISE will:

- Provide a means of access to all information available to young people at the school including accompanied visits, support from staff as readers or scribes, and ability-appropriate information resources.

Future Plans

RISE will continue to evaluate our access plans and disability provision including annual reviews with a disability access advisor.
